On Monday, May 19, 20 and 21, 2014 two groups of military veteran motorcycle enthusiasts called Run For The Wall (RFTW) www.rftw.org will be making their way through the great State of Tennessee. This run was started in 1989 (26years ago) by two veterans that starts in California and ends in Washington, D.C. on Memorial Day. Their Mission is "to promote healing among ALL veterans and their families and friends, to call for an accounting of all Prisoners of War and those Missing in Action (POW/MIA), to honor the memory of those Killed Action (KIA) from all wars, and to support our military personnel all over the world." This is the only group of motorcycle riders that are allowed to ride into Arlington Cemetery.

*The <u>Midway Route</u> will travel, on <u>Monday</u>, <u>May 19</u>, I-40 from the west Tennessee with an overnight stop in Cookeville, Exit 287 and on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 20</u>, perform a wreath laying ceremony at the East Tennessee Veterans Memorial with lunch, in Knoxville, gas stop at Exit 398, Strawberry Plains Pilot Station and east on I-40 to Exit 447, Citgo Station and onto North Carolina.

May 20: ETD from Cookeville 8:45am (local time);

ETA into Knoxville 11:15am departing at 12:55pm

ETA Strawberry Plains for gas at 1:10pm (Pilot station) departing 1:50pm

ETA Citgo Station for gas Exit 447 at 2:45pm departing 3:30pm

*The <u>Southern Route</u> will travel <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 20</u>, <u>2014</u>, I-75N with an overnight stop in Chattanooga, Exit 7B. On <u>Wednesday May 21</u>, <u>2014</u>, they will continue north on I-75 and connect with I-40 east with a gas stop at Exit 369 TA Truck Stop and continue north to I-81, gas stop at Exit 36, Greeneville and north into Virginia.

May 21: ETD from Chattanooga 8:30am; ETA Exit 369 Knoxville gas stop TA Truck

Stop 9:55am; ETD is 10:45am

ETA into Greeneville Exit 36 is 12:25pm: ETA is 1:10pm
