Home Repair Ministry provides labor and materials for low-income families who are unable to maintain their homes.

- Projects: adding electricity or running water, painting, room additions, repairs.
- 23 families were served in 2012.
- 1,300+ volunteers provide the physical labor.

Samaritan House Family Ministries provides a safe, warm, Christian environment for homeless families.

- Services: Christian counseling to help residents find a new home, a new job and a new hope in Christ; opportunities to learn and practice skills for independence.
- 45 families (50 adults & 47 children) were served in 2012.

Clothing & Furniture Ministries provide good, used clothing and furniture to struggling families.

- 4,353 individuals received assistance in 2012.

Food Pantry responds to an ever-increasing need by helping families on a regular basis or during an emergency.

- 1,451 families received 7,000+ baskets of food in 2012.
- Many families rely on the pantry EVERY month for food.

Children's Ministries ensure that children have the chance to learn about and grow in Christ.

- Activities: Bible Study, tutoring, and the Kid's Club.
