What is Relay For Life?

Relay For Life is the American Cancer Society's signature fund-raising event, bringing communities together in hope, celebration and memory. It is a unique event that offers everyone in the community an opportunity to participate in the fight against cancer. The overnight event remembers those who have lost the fight against cancer and honor those who have survived.

Who participates?

Everyone is encouraged to participate!

Teams of 10 to 15 people form from businesses, clubs, families, friends, hospitals, churches, schools and service organizations. These people share a common purpose- their support of the American Cancer Society's mission. During the event, team members take turns walking on the track and camping out overnight.

Why Relay For Life?

In the United States, men have a one in two lifetime risk of developing cancer; for women the risk is one in three. Relay For Life represents the hope that those lost to cancer will never be forgotten, that those who face cancer will be surrounded and that one day cancer will be eliminated.
